**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT** NTI Members call upon the Government of Nunavut to conduct a review of the adequacy of care for Elders in Nunavut communities including regular inspections of existing Elders' facilities and to upgrade these facilities where deficiencies exist.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT** the Members call upon the Government of Nunavut to allocate additional resources to ensure Elders receive adequate care in Nunavut.
