of Investigations and the Team Commanders, and ASIRT is deployed to commence its investigation.

ASIRT also has an existing agreement with the Yukon Government to conduct investigations into any serious incident involving its territorial police agency, which is the Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP).

Upon request and with the consent of the DLE and Executive Director, ASIRT may become involved as the primary investigative agency in the capacity of oversight of the investigation, as an independent reviewer of an RCMP investigation, or in the capacity of both oversight and review.

Lastly, ASIRT might become involved in an investigation as a result of a request made by the government of another jurisdiction to the Alberta Government.
