Dear Mr. Speaker,

I am reaching out to you as a follow up on my appearance in front of the Committee of the Whole for the Midterm Review on November 8, 2023. I wanted to follow up on a question raised by MLA Savikataaq. While I verbally provided the list of communities approved for the Municipal Parking Garage Program, I wasn't able to provide members of a breakdown of the phase for which each community is approved.

Below, Tables 1 and 2, identify the communities that have been approved for the program and the phase for which they are approved (planning or design) for the program. The tables include the total funding request, a description of the request and in the case of projects moving into design, the previous approved funding for the planning phase.
