MINISTERIAL BENEFITS POLICIES

The *Legislative Assembly and Executive Council Act*, S.Nu. 2002, c.5,

36. (2) Annual report by Premier

The Premier shall, during each fiscal year, cause a report to be laid before the Legislative Assembly

- (a) setting out any policies made under subsection 33.1 (2) in the previous fiscal year; and
- (b) showing the amounts paid pursuant to a policy made under subsection 33.1(2), by way of allowance, expense or benefit during the previous fiscal year to each person who have been a member of the Executive Council during that Fiscal year.

The Ministerial Benefits Policy, Reimbursement For Costs of Temporary Accommodation in Iqaluit (6) provides that Ministers who:

“...continue to maintain a primary residence in a community other than Iqaluit or Apex during the period of their appointment to Cabinet are eligible to claim reimbursement for costs incurred as a result of maintaining a residence in Iqaluit. These include the costs of rent, heat, electricity and utilities for the temporary accommodation that they occupy in Iqaluit, less the rent, if any, received from their primary residence.”
