Thank you for your letter on March 15, 2019, in which you have raised concerns about communications at Nunavut Arctic College, specifically at the Community Learning Centres.

As minister, I assure you there is no directive, policy or any other restriction in place from the college's Board of Governors, president or the senior management team. Further, all Nunavut Arctic College premises, including the Community Learning Centres, are open to the general public. I welcome all members to our institutions of learning and encourage you to have open dialogue with any of our staff, faculty and learners.

Internet use across at the college is the same standard internet connectivity that most departments and agencies use. We make do with what is available to us. This makes it challenging to access audio and video files, but we're subject to the same email and internet usage policies used by the Government of Nunavut. If the network is congested with users, connection speeds are affected.

Please continue to raise your concerns with me.
