Expand day care or build new facility

### Additional Information

Our current day care was mismanaged as the executive director was managing the finances and the day-to-day operations without having the proper pay or training to operate the facility. The Hamlet would consider managing the finances of the day care and allow the day care supervisor to manage the administrative aspects of the day care. This would allow the day care staff to focus on the children instead of focusing on a number of different administrative tasks. The current day care facility is boarded up and we are unsure of the status of the facility. They also liquidated all of the assets in the day care to recoup any losses. In order to get the day care operating again, it would require all new equipment and a in-depth analysis of the current status of the facility.

### Additional Information

The Community Hall is the mainstay of our recreation programs and it harbors up to 100 kids nightly who engage in physical activity, sporting events and cultural activities. In addition, it is rented out to various agencies and private or community groups who need a venue for public meetings or events. Security is an issue as break ins have occurred and new doors / locking mechanisms need to be upgraded. There are ongoing issues with plumbing and heating which keeps our Maintainer busy. The Building is quite old, probably has asbestos and needs to be replaced or at the very least renovated.

### Description

### Additional Information

Main issue is inadequate space and squalid conditions for the employees.

Nursing residence should be larger as currently not up to respectful standard for anyone to live in. The HC facility does contain asbestos and that is a concern. Security is a serious concern as break ins have occurred while the head nurse was actually asleep - security has to be upgraded. Utility expense is very high given the age of the facility, and a new building would be much more effective in this regard.

### Additional Information

Community requires a proper break water to allow for safer docking and to prevent damages to boats caused by high winds. Accessing the shoreline now is difficult due to shallow locations with hidden rocks - this makes exiting or entering the dock area treacherous. In addition, the community is seeking a fish plant to increase jobs and boost the local economy. There has been a feasibility study on the harvesting of the turbot and we are process of finding ways to move forward with the studies.

## Municipal Garages and Buildings

### Description

Expand 3 bay garage to 4 bay garage

### Additional Information

We currently have a number of vehicles that are being parked outside due to lack of space (Backhoe and spare sewage truck and tractor). During the winter months these vehicles are starting to see major wear and tear due to the weather. By expanding our garage it would allow us to properly store all of our vehicles. Since the 3 bay garage is heated it would also allow us to be able to safe on having to warm up the vehicles for an extended period of time during the winter months. Snow going into the vehicle during the winter and vandalism during the summer months are extremely common.

### Additional Information

Our community did receive two 10 plexes 1-2 bedroom units. This did help our community but our demand still remains extremely high. We require 3-4 bedroom units within our community to accommodate families in our community. The Nunavut Housing Strategy has been a great starting point for understanding the need, now we need action to happen within our community to decrease our housing needs. If more public housing was created in our community, we believe we would see an increase in employment and greater community collaboration (as also identified in the Nunavut Housing Strategy).

### Additional Information

We currently only have a gravel pad for a floor and we need a concrete floor to enhance year round usage of the building. In addition, we require some type of equipment to allow for easy and safe changing of ceiling lights and in addition, we need a new Zamboni door which has been damaged beyond repair due to break ins. A proper door would eliminate break ins at our Arena. Thermo siphons would also help keep the arena open longer. This would be a huge benefit in our community as we believe we would see a decrease in a lot of social issues.

The location should be in an area not visible to the town, the location should be further to the north (approximately 3 miles). there was a site identified when the old Clyde River clean up project was underway, since abandoned due to lack of funds but a there is a roadway to the site and the lower valley is perfect for a new land fill. Burning garbage Smoke would not end up in town as is the case now with our current landfill location. It would also not attract Polar Bears too close to town as they do occasionally visit the current dump for a snack. The fencing around the current solid waste site isn't high enough and debris is being blown out of the dump into our community. A feasibility study will be our next step to see if it is feasible to put the solid waste site towards Black Bluff Hill.
