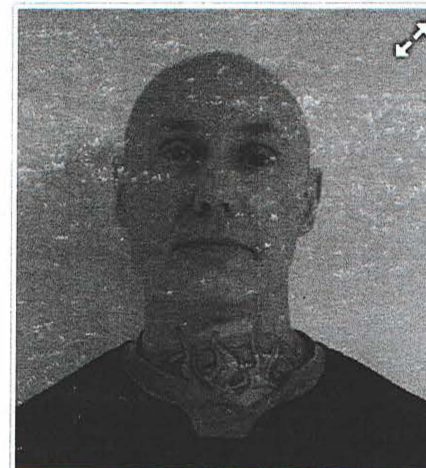
Nova Scotia RCMP is advising all citizens, particularly those in the South Brookfield area of Queens County, of the release of a high risk offender.

Scott Desrosiers, 53, was released from the Jamieson Community Correctional Centre in Dartmouth on December 24, 2019 after completing a sentence for sexual offences. He initially resided in New Brunswick however has had his parole conditions changed, and relocated to Queens County in December. He has a criminal record dating back to 1989 that includes convictions for two counts of Aggravated Sexual Assault, two counts of Theft, Forcible Confinement, Break and Enter, and Uttering Threats. He is described as white, 6-foot-1 and 186 pounds, with hazel eyes and brown hair.

Desrosiers is subject to a number of conditions, including:

- No association with individuals with a criminal record
- No possession of weapons, and no possession of knives or sharp instruments outside the home
- No consumption or possession of alcohol or non prescription drugs, or prescription drugs not prescribed to him
- No entry to businesses where alcohol is sold or consumed or is the primary source of business
- No direct communication with past victims or family members of past victims
- No personal or romantic relationships without prior notification to police

This information is provided to alert members of the public of his presence in our community so they may take suitable precautionary measures. The RCMP is unreasonable conduct will not be tolerated.

## Public interest notification - High risk offender - Taylor Albert Dueck

The Mission RCMP has issued the following public interest warning under the Privacy Act of Canada regarding the release of a dangerous sex offender who poses a high risk to re-offend.

Taylor Dueck was released from prison on February 3rd, 2020 and is currently residing in Mission, British Columbia.

- Taylor Albert Dueck - 25 years old
- Height 5'11
- Weight 130 lbs
- Brown hair and Blue eyes

Dueck has a criminal history which includes sexual assault x 2, sexual assault on a person under 16 years of age and sexual assault using a weapon.

Dueck has been deemed a high risk to re-offend sexually and poses a risk to the safety of female children under the age of 18 years old.

Dueck is currently subject to court ordered conditions which include:

- Not to possess or consume alcohol or controlled substance except as prescribed by a licenced physician
- Subject to a daily curfew between the hours of 9:00pm and 6:00am
- Not to possess any weapons
