Title: Government of Nunavut Expenditures on Overtime Pay

Expressing the information in a comparable format to that which was provided in Returns to Written Questions 7-4(2) and 15-4(3), what were the Government of Nunavut's expenditures on overtime pay for indeterminate, term, casual and relief employees during the 2016-2017 fiscal year for each of its departments, Crown agencies and territorial corporations?
2. Broken down by employing entity (department, Crown agency and territorial corporation) and employment status (indeterminate, term, casual and relief), how many employees received between \$0.01 and \$25,000.00 in overtime pay during the 2016-2017 fiscal year?
3. Broken down by employing entity (department, Crown agency and territorial corporation) and employment status (indeterminate, term, casual and relief), how many employees received between \$25,000.01 and \$50,000.00 in overtime pay during the 2016-2017 fiscal year?
4. Broken down by employing entity (department, Crown agency and territorial corporation) and employment status (indeterminate, term, casual and relief), how many employees received between \$50,000.01 and \$99,999.99 in overtime pay during the 2016-2017 fiscal year?

5. Broken down by employing entity (department, Crown agency and territorial corporation) and employment status (indeterminate, term, casual and relief), how many employees received in excess of \$100,000.00 in overtime pay during the 2016-2017 fiscal year?
6. What specific audit activities are undertaken by the Department of Finance in relation to departments, Crown agencies and territorial corporations that incur annual overtime costs in excess of \$1,000,000.00?
